- C. Tipton moved Perry 2nd to approve agenda as presented all yes all yes motion carried.

- F. Village Administrator/Police. This report is on file with the clerk. Discussion took place on the old salt spreader. It is in need of a costly repair. A quote for the purchase of a new one was presented to council. This spreader can be purchased through the state bid program. Tipton moved Bonnough 2nd to approve the purchase of a VMaxx spreader as presented at the cost of \$5,665.51, all yes motion carried. The village will try to sell the old one or perhaps trade it in. It was reported that the Solar project on ongoing, the representatives for this project have been in contact with the zoning inspector. Mr. Carroll will contact Mr. Phil Wenig concerning this is as well, this area will not be able to be farmed. The police vehicle has been ordered and a bike rack for the police department. Nancy Perry inquired about the rate study, the King Road property for sale on the status of the fire department building. Mr. Carroll reported that he had taken the Village's offer for the fire department to Middleton Township. Middleton Township stated that the offer will not work for them. This discussion now will be between the attorneys.
- **G. Public Presentations and Hearings:** Mr. Bob Stichler approached council concerning a special use permit for the Liberty High (514) property he purchased from the Village of Haskins. Mr. Stichler is seeking a special use permit for this property; he will be building two single family homes on the property. The property is currently zoning C-1, neighborhood commercial. Tipton moved Snyder 2nd to grant this special use permit under the C-1 408.1 section, all yes motion carried. Ms. Perry inquired to if Mr. Stichler was to sell, how this effect the property would. This special use permit will follow the property not the owner.
