Reports, communications, appointments, and confirmations, from the mayor, directors, of departments, and other village officers: Mayor Heft thanked public for attending the recent planning commission meeting concerning the Dollar General Site plan that was proposed. The site plan was incomplete allowing for the planning commission to reject the plan. This however allowed for much discussion on the village zoning and zoning code. Mike Richardson voiced his disconcern against the Dollar General along with 90% of the village residents that signed the petition that was circulated. Mayor Heft reported that the property at 64/582 is zoning C-1, the same as the property located at 64/King. The consensus being that the village residents do not want a Dollar General in the Village and that the zoning of C-1 does not fit this type of business. Mayor Heft reported that the OML will be sponsoring a Night at the Mud hens on August 25th for anyone wanting to attend.

Mr. Richardson would also like to see the village planning commission look at section 110 of the Haskins Village zoning code, he feels this could be better written with Mayor Heft stating that is was open for interpretation however Haskins Village has the last say.
