Resolution R-2019-9

CERTIFICATION FOR A RENEWAL AND INCREASE OF AN EXISTING TAX

Declaring that amount of taxes that may be collected by levy at the maximum rate authorized by law without a vote of the electors to be insufficient and declaring that necessity of a levy in excess of such rate.

Be it resolved, by the Council of Haskins Village, Wood County, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of taxes at the maximum rate authorized by **Revised Code Section 5705.02** on the taxable property in Haskins Village will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village and that it is necessary for the purpose of providing additional funds for

Street construction and Reconstruction

Of the Village, that of 5 years, at the rate in excess of such maximum rate authorized by said **Revised Code Section 5705.02**.

SECTION 2: That it is expedient and necessary to levy taxes for the years 2020 2021 2022 2023 and 2024 at the rate for each year of renew 2 mills and increase of .5 on each dollar of the tax valuation of the taxable property within Haskins Village in excess of the rate authorized by said **Revised Code Section 5705.02**, in accordance with the provisions of **Section 5705.19(G)**.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk be, and is hereby directed to certify a copy of the Resolution to the Board of Elections of Wood County, Ohio, in order that said Board of Elections may make the necessary arrangements for the submission of such question to the Electors of said village, as provided by law, at the General Election to be held on November 5th 2019

SECTION 4: That the notice of election and form of the ballot to be cast herein shall specify that the levy herein submitted is renewal of an existing levy of 2 mills and increase of .5 mills.

VILLAGE OF HASKINS WOOD COUNTY, OHIO

Resolution to proceed with a ballot issue submitting the question of a tax levy renewal to the voters of the Village of Haskins, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Haskins, Ohio, has passed Resolution R-2019-9 certifying to the Wood County Auditor the necessity to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation, and Whereas, the Wood County Auditor issued a Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue on July 15th 2019

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village of Haskins, Ohio, that

1. The Village of Haskins, Ohio, shall proceed with a ballot issue submitting to the voters of the Village of Haskins, Ohio, and a tax renewal and an increase for the purpose of Street construction and reconstruction expenses.

2. The tax renewal of 2 mills with an increase of .50 mills rate shall be two and five tenths (2.5) mills for each one dollar in tax valuation, and shall be levied for tax years 2020, 2021 2022, 2023 and 2024.

3. The Wood County Auditor has estimated the property tax revenue produced by the stated millage to be \$48,836.21 the total tax valuation of the Village used in calculating the estimated property tax millage rate is \$23,293,950.

4. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Wood County Board of Elections in order that said Board of Elections may make the necessary arrangements for the submission of such question to the electors of the Village of Haskins, as provided by law, at the general election to be held November 5th 2019.

5. This measure is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents. The reason for such emergency is that this resolution must be submitted to the Wood County Board of Elections not later than August 7th 2019, in order for the ballot measure to be properly placed on the ballot November 5th 2019 General Election. The money that will be raised by passage of the ballot measure is necessary for the Street Construction and Reconstruction for the Village.

6. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
