

ORDINANCE NO: O-2023-1

VILLAGE OF HASKINS, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FIXED RATE TO BE CHARGED BY THE VILLAGE OF HASKINS, OHIO, FOR STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Village of Haskins has determined a charge for Storm Sewer improvements is necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of its residents;

WHEREAS, on December 15, 1997, the Council of Haskins Village adopted Ordinance Number 390 which established a fixed rate of \$2.00 for the Storm Sewer Improvements, adopted Ordinance O-2018-4 amending Ordinance Number 390 setting the Storm Sewer improvement charge to a fixed rate of \$4.00 per unit, per month, and adopted Ordinance O-2019-6 amending Ordinance O-2018-4, and adopted Ordinance O-2020-7 amending Ordinance O-2019-7, and adopted Ordinance O-2023-1 amending Ordinance O-2020-7.

WHEREAS, the Streets and Utilities Committee of the Council of Haskins Village approved changes to the Fixed Rate set for Storm Sewer Improvements and following the recommendation of the Rate Study completed in 2020 it is recommended to the Council of Haskins Village that such changes be adopted, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Haskins, Wood County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The storm sewer improvement charge shall consist of a fixed rate following the listed rate/time table below.

2024	Effective – 1 st Billing Cycle of 2024	\$14.00 per unit, per month
2025	Effective – 1 st Billing Cycle of 2025	\$16.00 per unit, per month
2026	Effective – 1 st Billing Cycle of 2026	\$18.00 per unit, per month

Section 2: All monies received as a result of the storm sewer improvement charge shall be deposited in the Storm Sewer Improvement Fund.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
